Our **Independently Published Authors Program** allows us to devote more time and expertise to the success of your book.

First, leave a copy of your book for review. We'll determine if your book is right for our market. *Please complete the back side of this brochure.*

CONSIGNMENT: *THE BASICS*

- Basic handling fee: \$25.00 per title.
- Hicklebee's will pay a maximum of 60% of the retail.
- Hicklebee's will initially take four copies of the book.
- Hicklebee's will carry the book for three months.
- During the initial 3-month period, Hicklebee's may contact the consignor to request additional copies of the book, and/or pay for items that have sold.
- At the end of the consignment period, Hicklebee's will contact you to pick up any books that have not sold and issue payment for books sold.
- Hicklebee's will donate books left more than 6 months.

Additional Possibilities

For an additional \$30 per title:

Make your books available online with placement on Hicklebee's website for the duration of the consignment period.

(Please note: it can take up to 2 weeks from the start of the consignment period to be added to our website's database.)

For an additional \$100:

A book signing with other local authors . This includes an announcement in Hicklebee's email newsletter (a 4,200+ opt-in list of devoted book enthusiasts), website exposure, and local newspaper promotion.

(We schedule local author days 1-4 times a year depending on demand.)

For these options you must provide:

- **A short, critical review of your books (50 words or less)**
- **A JPEG image of your book cover for our website and e-mails.**

For an author event we require a minimum of 10 copies of your book.

***Fees go toward data entry, display and promotions, which all require extra time and expense.*

Tips for Success

- Encourage your family, friends, business associates, and others to purchase your book from Hicklebee's.
- Contact your local media and mailing lists to let them know that your book is available at Hicklebee's.
- Send out press releases, review copies and other promotional material.
- Get involved with book clubs, libraries and other community organizations. Greater success comes from a wide variety of author-coordinated promotions.
